

Errata

Upon the publication of *Moneywise* in June 2009 it was noticed that several of the charts in the Gallery section of the book were lacking certain indicators. All the charts in the Gallery section are printed below.

Specifically, Charts 6, 7, 9 and 10, on pages 271, 272, 274, and 275 all mentioned Bollinger Bands, but those bands did not print at all.

Also, Charts 11 and 13, on pages 276 and 278 were supposed to have numbers indicating a different Elliott Waves, but those numbers did not print.

On page 97 I mention the Microsoft Money software, a package I have used for several years to handle my personal and business finances. Two days after *Moneywise* appeared in print Microsoft announced that they would no longer be offering Microsoft Money, effective 30 June 2009. That leaves Quicken and QuickBooks as the primary mass-marketed personal financial and small business software packages. I stopped using Quicken several years ago because at that time it was not capable of dealing with the more sophisticated investment transactions; that may no longer be the case.
